Kindergarten 2024-2025- Round Up April 12, 2024

If you have a child, or know of a child who will turn 5 prior to July 31, 2024 please contact the Westmont office at 402-895-9602. You may also send an email to: june.jordening@spcsne.org

Proof of residency is the first step in the enrollment process and it may be emailed to me or you may send it to Lisa Peterson @ lisa.peterson@spcsne.org. This must be on file prior to being invited to round up.

Kindergarten round up consists of 2 sessions, an a.m. and a p.m. session. Your child will be invited to **ONE** of these. You will receive a letter, or email, several weeks in advance letting you know which session your child has been assigned to.

A parent meeting will be held the evening before here at Westmont at 6 p.m. to help you understand the process and answer any questions you may have.

If you have filled out option enrollment forms to have your child attend Kindergarten at Westmont in the fall, your acceptance will be determined later and you will be notified by our District Office. You will be invited to attend the parent meeting and to send your child to round up, if you'd like.

To help you begin the process, a birth certificate, immunization record, and a physical will be needed prior to your child starting kindergarten. The physical **MUST** be within 6 months of the start of school. If you have any questions, please contact the office.



Boys Town Social Skills

Each day our counselor, Ms. Susman, teaches a different Boys Town Social Skill. In an effort to increase the students' use of these skills, they are added to the newsletter each week. Our hope is that you will reinforce these important skills at home.

Monday, March 18th: Asking for Help:

1. Look at the person.
2. Ask the person if he or she has time to help you.
3. Clearly explain the kind of help you need.
4. Thank the person for helping.

Tuesday, March 19th: Staying on Task:

1. Look at your task or assignment.
2. Think about the steps needed to complete the task.
3. Focus all of your attention on your task.
4. Stop working only when instructed.
5. Ignore distractions and interruptions from others.

Wednesday, March 20th: Using an Appropriate Voice Tone:

1. Listen to the level of the voices around you.
2. Change your voice to match.
3. Watch and listen for visual or verbal cues, and adjust your voice as needed.

Thursday, March 21st: Working with Others (Being a Team):

1. Identify the task to be completed.
2. Assign tasks to each person.
3. Discuss ideas in a calm, quiet voice, and let everyone share his or her ideas.
4. Work on tasks until completed.

Friday, March 22nd: Listening to Others:

1. Look at the person who is talking and remain quiet.
2. Wait until the person is finished talking before you speak.
3. Show that you heard the person by nodding your head, saying "Okay" or "That's interesting," etc.
